MAX-26 Container — Built for a Perfect Fit. Shipping a bike with handlebar controls is easy with the MAX-26. Simply unhook the two brake cables and two derailleur cables so the handlebar assembly fits cleanly over the rear wheel.

Need extra room? Turn the fork backward or remove it and place it securely at the bottom of the container. Remove the pedals and seat, then wrap them in newspaper or bubble wrap for added protection.

Before sealing, give the container a gentle shake. If you hear nothing your bike is fully protected and ready to ship. Size is 59 x 10" x 29" or 137" dimensional inches or 16,960 cubic inches.

Now it's time to prepare your Econ 2 shipping container (53 x 8 x 30 inches)

#3



Unfold the container so it matches this image. Fold each flap back and forth (3) times to form the box.

#2



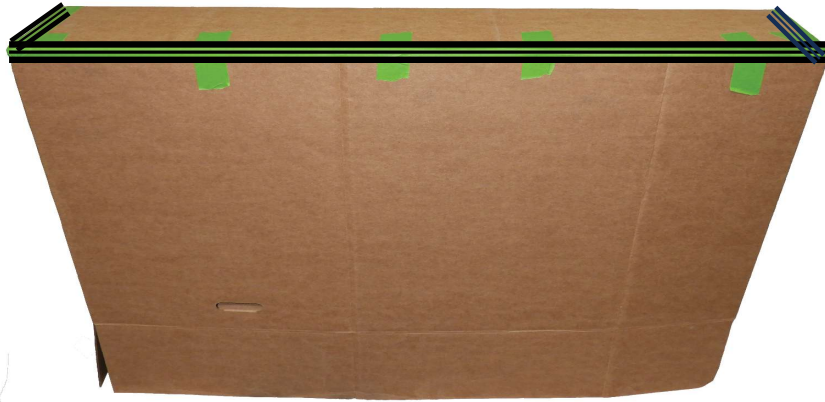
Stand your container upright.

#4



Use 6 to 8 short pieces of packing tape to close the bottom flap.

#5



Tape all three sides down with packing tape and flip the Econ-2 over.



#7



Fill the bottom with crumpled protective paper or bubble wrap. Lower the bicycle in the Econ2 and fill completely to the top with paper or bubble wrap.

#6



Fold the small and large flaps back and fourth three times.

#8

Tape down all of the exposed edges of the container. Print your return address on the right side of the container. Once it's all taped down, shake the container, if you still hear parts rattling open and add more material. Final step go to SHIP A BOX.
